at Strathclyde Park. More progress is expected over the next month.

LF, IJW, and TD attended a meeting of Edinburgh canal users at which the subject of session times was discussed. The main point of current contention concerns GHSBC 'extending' its Saturday morning exclusive slot into the earlier and later non-exclusive sessions, thus affecting adversely the St Andrew senior and junior sessions respectively.

No agreement was reached and the matter is ongoing.

Boathouse development RR reported no concrete progress although he has been chasing it along and will

continue to do so.

BRFC with outside caterers appears to have 'worked' and been popular.

Constitution At a prior meeting RR suggested that the present Constitution of the Club contains a

For example, presently, the elected President must chair each meeting (impractical because George Hunter does not attend regularly); and the voting rights (at general meetings) are not entirely clear.
