Minutes of previous

meeting

The board agreed that the Minutes of the previous meeting were a true and accurate reflection of that meeting. The board adopted the Minutes of the previous meeting.

Finance Junior circuit training – the club incurs a cost (payable to Energy Gym) for providing this

service which is not sustainable on the current basis of pricing. It was agreed to review

prices charged to juniors (for attending circuits) by next meeting.

Eventbrite (a web-based event and subscription collection service) - the club has been looking at alternatives to the present provider which has evident security loopholes. According to JC, Eventbrite is "not cheap". However, it was agreed to use it since it provides the functionality and security needed. JC asked that somebody else administer Eventbrite because she has increasing pressures on her time owing to the growing time required to administer the Club's general accounts.

Audit. The committee acknowledged that the deadline for completion of an audit of the accounts for the year ended 3 July 2016, is 30 April 2017.

Coaching. LF is preparing a coaching manual for the club. The content will mainly be obtained from the British Rowing manual. It is an effort to harmonise a club rowing
